Reading Matters

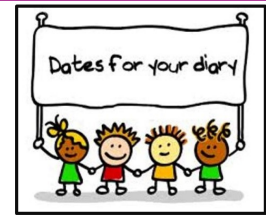
As always we are looking at ways of improving the reading ability of pupils at Merlin Top. For years 4,5 and 6 we will be starting a new scheme called 'Accelerated Reader' and changes will be made to the corridor area outside Years 4 and 5. Children in these year groups will be encouraged to read more books through an online interactive tool, which measure fluency and comprehension skills. As children read more their 'score' and word count grows. As a result of this new initiative we are in the process of ordering new books for the library and now have a substantial number of books to give away. On Friday 20th April from 2.30pm onwards we will be inviting children into the hall to select books to take home. Parents can also look at the books from 3.15pm onwards.
