Despite the cold weather and snow we will be giving out approximately 123 100% T-shirts next Wednesday. I know this has been a difficult term and the weather certainly makes everything much harder. Nevertheless, when school is open ALL children are expected to attend unless they are ill. Miss Whitcombe and Miss Lansbury-Palmer have reviewed all of our attendance data for this half term and a number of parents will be receiving letters (around 40 in total) regarding '**Persistent Absence**'. This is a definition applied to ALL children whose attendance falls below 90%. If you receive one of these letters, PLEASE make sure you take the time to attend as non-attendance and continued low attendance may result in fines being issued. This is in addition and different to the fines that are issued for holidays during term time. Generally speaking, this is not an option that schools want to take however the overall PA (Persistent absence) figure for Merlin Top is high at 11.5% when compared to the national average of 10.5%.

If your child is ill, please contact school as soon as possible to let us know, also please could you make sure we have correct contact details for your child.

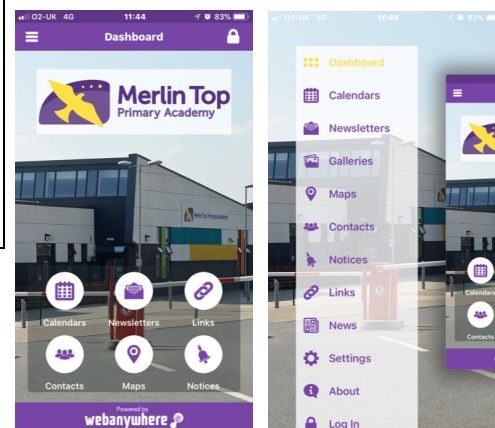
