

**Aims:**

- To support parents by providing early morning childcare from 8:00am to 8:45am
- To offer pupils the opportunity of having a healthy breakfast at the start of the day in a safe and friendly environment.

**Sessions:**

The Breakfast Club will run Monday to Friday term-time only. Breakfast Club will run from 8am to 8:45am. No entries will be permitted after 8:30am, unless extreme circumstances have prevailed, in which case it is at the discretion of the Breakfast Club Supervisor. The club only operates for children attending Merlin Top Primary Academy and is open to all pupils throughout the academy. At 8:45 pupils will go to their classroom in line with our new opening times.

**What we provide:**

- The club will provide a variety of age appropriate activities for pupils to take part in, these may include but will not be limited to:
  - Reading
  - Board Games
  - Homework
  - Other such activities deemed suitable
- At least two members of staff in attendance at any time.
- Staff will care for children, treating them with respect at all times.
- Complies with environmental health food safety standard.

**What we expect:**

- All children are expected to behave well, show respect, be polite, look after equipment and resources, and be courteous to staff and to each other. Those who do not may either be temporarily or permanently excluded depending on the circumstances.
- Children will not be allowed to leave the Breakfast Club to play outside.
- Parents are asked to keep the school informed of any changes to their contact details via the main office.

**Charges:**

The Breakfast Club operates the following charging policy.

- Standard minimum daily spend - 50p
- The club does not offer credit and all fees must be paid on the day or can be paid for the week in advance, if you wish.

**Ethos & policies:**

The Breakfast Club will function under the ethos and support of all school policies, E.g. Behaviour policy, equal opportunities etc.
